FISH HATCHERY FOR THIS CITY

FISH COMMISSION WILL
VISIT PETOSKEY

Next Spring and Investigate Probable
Site for New Plant—Old Hatch-
ery Was Had Near Site of
Arlington Hotel—Fish
for Round Lake.

The following letter to John L. A. Galster bringing considerable speculation as to whether the Michigan fish commission will decide, next spring, to establish another fish hatchery here in Petoskey.

Years ago there was a hatchery here but for some reason it was removed to Big Rapids or Paris where it is now being successfully operated. Mr. Galster, Representative D. H. Hinkley, backed by the proposed Petoskey Rod and Gun club, will make every effort to have the state bring such an attraction to this city and the men will consider every phase of the affair before making their decision.

The letter is as follows:

Dear Sir—Through Hon. D. H. Hinkley, we have received your recent letters relative to the application of Mr. Lindig, also as to the merits of Petoskey as a site for a fish hatchery. We have made no investigation as to the latter, but will do so next year and will be pleased to send our representative to Petoskey to look over the situation carefully.

We expect to make a shipment of bass to Mr. Lindig, for Round lake, during the present month or early in October. We were unable to supply wall-eyed pike this season, as weather conditions for collecting the eggs were very bad and the work was nearly a failure. However, we will carry his application over and no doubt will be able to take care of it next season.
