X The new dock is 565 feet long. From shore for a distance of 165 feet it is 18 feet wide, the outer 100 feet is forty feet wide. The outer 210 feet is 10 feet above the surface of the water with one slip in center of west side of outer 100 feet-one in center of east side of said 100 feet, and one in center of north end. Direction about 7 degrees west of north. To ascertain the depth of water at the new dock a committee consisting of W. L. McManus, John Seibert and W. W. McOmber took soundings yesterday with following result. At outer end 19 feet deep 100 feet from end 15 deep, 200 feet from end 10 feet deep, 250 feet from end 8 feet deep. So far as depth of water is concerned there seems to be no reason why the larger boats should not land there.
