Mr. Ramsby's car left the icy road and struck a tree at Oden while he and a party of Alanson folk were returning home from a shopping trip to Petoskey.

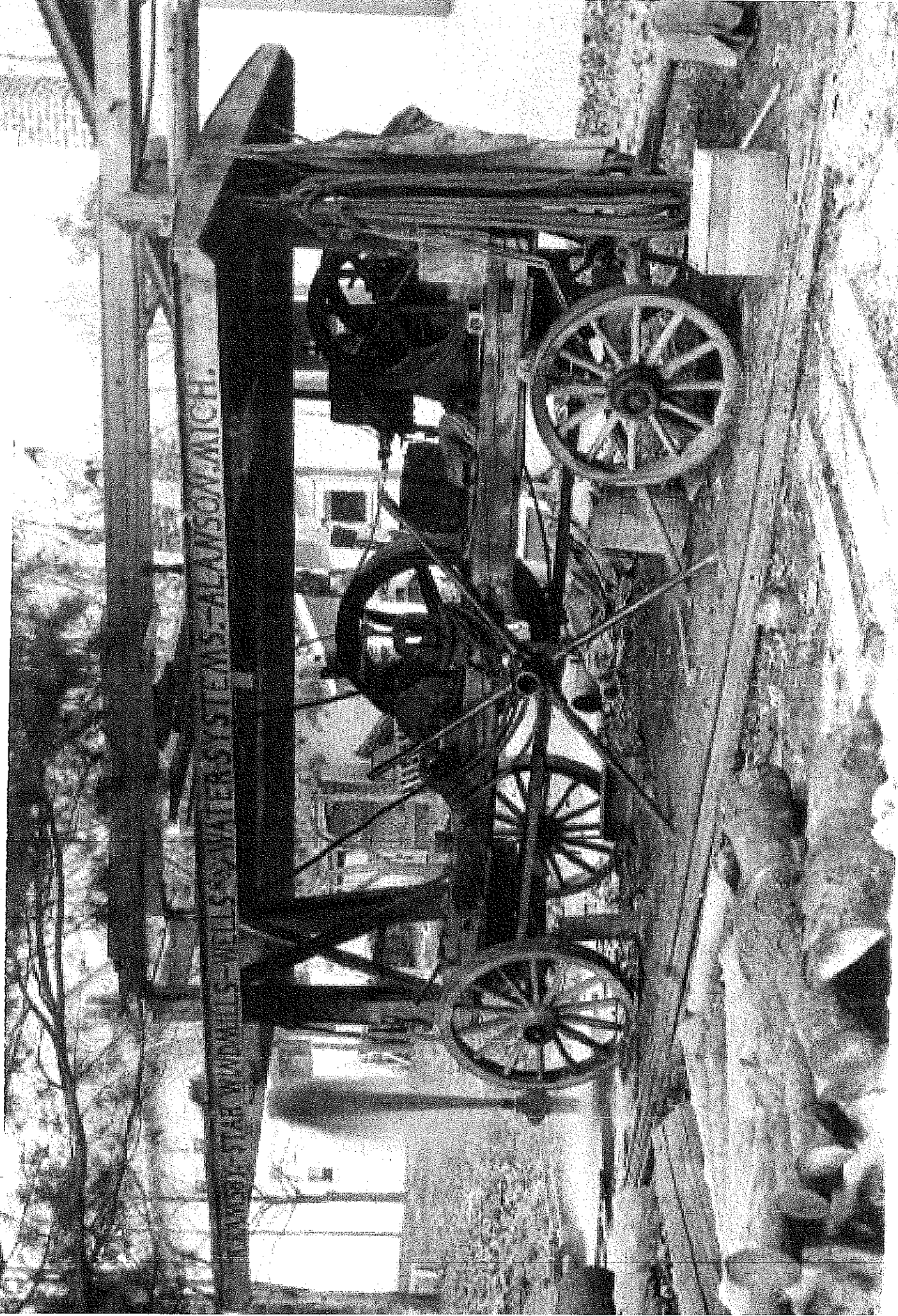
Mr. Ramsby for many years was in the well drilling business, working all over Northern Michigan. He was well known throughout the region.
