NEW RESTAURANT OPENS SATURDAY

MARYJON CAFE OPERATED
BY GEORGE BATSAKIS
ON MITCHELL ST.

Opening of the new Maryjon Cafe at 320 Mitchell street was announced for Saturday by George Batsakis today.

Mr. Batsakis, partner in the Arcadia Restaurant for a number of years, recently purchased the fixtures of the restaurant formerly operated by John Laggis and will open it under the name of the Maryjon Cafe. Mr. Batsakis will continue his connection with Arcadia.

A tile linoleum floor has been laid in the restaurant and the counter, soda fountain and food cases re-arranged so that the counter is in the front of the building. Booths line the west side and tables will be placed in the center. The room has been entirely re-decorated.

The restaurant will be in charge of George Vlahakis who came here from Lansing. A chef is being brought from Detroit.

Mr. Batsakis said the new restaurant would be open Saturday morning, serving regular meals, and will specialize in salads and sandwiches along with its short-order menu.
