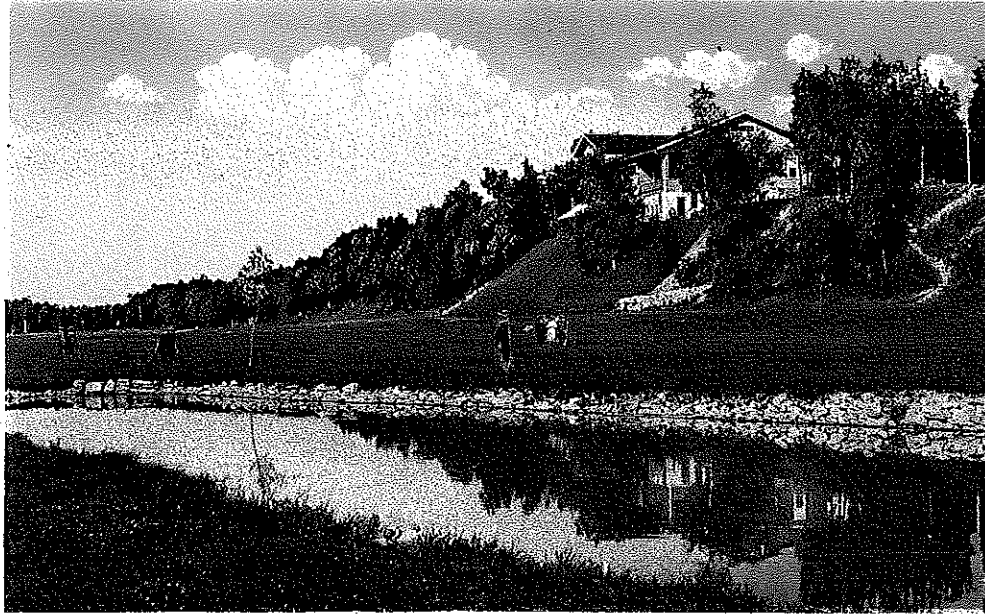
Petoskey has for long years advertised itself as a summer watering place, but of late years people have demanded more than water and air of the resorts where they summer and Petoskey has lagged behind even the smallest of nearby resorts. Where is your golf course? is asked and everyone is forced to answer, "We have none." Petoskey has also been lacking for good tennis courts, croquet grounds, ball grounds, playgrounds for the children, casino advantages where dancing and bowling can be had and many other desirable features for resorts.

Tuesday Mr. Turner, president of the Pennsylvania lines, was in Petoskey and while here called upon Leon Chichester, of the First State bank, urging that steps be taken to secure a desirable golf course in Petoskey and said he believed a golf course is needed here worse than anything else and also that without a golf course Petoskey, as a resort, will go backward instead of forward in spite of all else that can be done.
